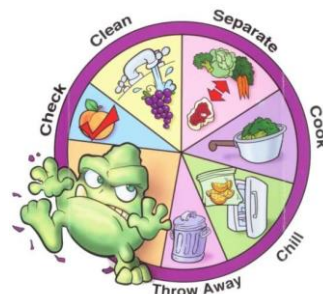

World Water Day

Worldwide, 663 million people live without improved drinking water sources. A lack of clean water is a significant development challenge. In areas of the world where

access to water is limited, local Presbyterian World Service & Development partners are responding to improve water sources, build new ones and train volunteers to maintain wells. Support to improve sanitation ensures water stays clean and prevents the spread of illness. PWS&D equips communities to build hand-washing facilities and latrines and educates members about proper hygiene. The results of this program are transformative and far reaching—clean water allows women and men to harvest crops, care for their families, expand their livelihoods and lead healthy, productive lives.

Don Miller is the guest speaker. He was born in a little out-of-the-way place in the middle of Zululand, in Southern Africa. A year later his parents moved to Swaziland where they lived for 12 years. After a brief stay in South Africa, the family immigrated to Canada and settled in Sarnia, Ontario. After attending school in Chicago and Toronto, Don ended up settling in Ottawa.

Don moved to Ottawa to be a part of Arlington Woods Free Methodist Church. For many years he was the Youth Pastor and Assistant/Associate Pastor involved in many aspects of church life. For the last six years, he was the Senior Pastor providing leadership to the congregation.

In 2006 Don worked for YOUCAN, as Director of Development. YOUCAN is a by-youth, for-youth organization that does conflict resolution training. Then, in the spring of 2007, he joined the Canadian Bible Society as their Eastern Ontario Director and later the Director of Canadian Ministry.

Don joined the World Relief Canada team in the fall of 2016 as the Director of Church Engagement. Don's passion is to help pastors, churches and leaders partner with God to build transforming relationships with people and communities living in poverty around the world.

Most recently Don was in Tanzania where he experienced first-hand the impact of the work of World Relief Canada. Visiting Conservation Agriculture and Village Saving and Loans projects in several remote communities.

He is a graduate of the [Arrow Leadership Program](#) for young leaders in Canada. His interests include travel, reading, camping, basketball and war history.
