Financial update

The information for the 3 months ending March 31 is presented as actual givings, the "adjusted" target for the 3 months ending March 31 and the target for 2017 as a whole. Adjusted means the target for the first quarter of the year is presented as the typical percentage share of annual givings during the year for local purposes and Presbyterians Sharing. For example, givings during the first quarter are typically 21.5 per cent of the actual total givings for the year for local purposes and 19.5 per cent for Presbyterians Sharing. As can be seen in the table, actual givings are well below the target for local purposes, somewhat below the target for Presbyterians Sharing and a little above the target for the loan repayment.
