
General Reminders: Please turn off all lights as you leave, including those in the corridors and the chandelier at the front entrance. Security lights will remain on automatically.

to refugee sponsorship efforts in 2016. In 2016, 73 sponsorship applications were filed for 244 people, with families from Syria, Burundi, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Egypt, Eritrea, Iran, Iraq, Liberia, Pakistan, Burma and Venezuela arriving safely in Canada. We celebrate the compassionate efforts of Presbyterians across Canada who are responding to God's call to serve and defend the vulnerable and the persecuted.
