Financial Update

The information for the three-month period of April to June is presented as actual givings, "seasonal" quarterly target for this period and the approved target for the year as a whole.

As shown in the table, actual givings were below the target for both local purposes and Presbyterians Sharing and a little above target for the loan repayment.

The shortfall in givings for local purposes was smaller than the shortfall for the first three months of the year. But the cumulative shortfall for the six months to June 30 is over \$9,000. The cumulative shortfall for Presbyterians Sharing is \$760.
