Reverend Ken MacLaren is the Executive Director of Ottawa Innercity Ministries, a faith-based NGO agency that has been helping the poor and homeless since 1988. Ken has a B.A. from the University of Western Ontario (1979, Dean's Honor List), a M.Div. from the Lutheran Theological Seminary,

Saskatoon (1983), and a Th.M. from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, Deerfield, Illinois (1984). He has been ordained with the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada since 1986. Following his formal education, Ken was the Senior Pastor of three churches in three provinces with the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada (1986-91). He was a member of the National Social Concerns Committee of the P.A.O.C. (1991) and initiated and developed a National Capital Men's Ministry Network in Ottawa in 2001. Ken has been married for 38 years, has three adult children and four grandchildren (all under the age of 8).

Ken has served as Executive Director of OIM since May, 2003. He has been a member of the National Advisory for Street Level Canada, formerly the Evangelical Fellowship of Canada's Roundtable on Poverty and Homelessness since 2004. Ken considers it a privilege to work among the poor and disenfranchised in downtown Ottawa. He says, "All of my education and experience has made me qualified to serve sandwiches to the poor."

This year marks the 500th anniversary of the Reformation.

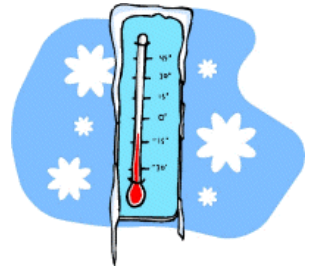

### HOT or COLD?



Now that colder weather is coming, we need to remember comfort when we plan a meeting or event.

The building is divided into 4 heating zones - each zone is pre-programmed for all

weekly-scheduled events and should bring the temperature up in time for the event:

1. Upper Level (except Sanctuary) - thermostat in corridor near Gathering Place (also air-conditioned!)
2. Sanctuary - thermostat on south wall.
3. Lower Level (except Fellowship Hall) - thermostat in back corridor
4. Fellowship Hall and front corridor near washrooms - thermostat on south wall of Fellowship Hall

If you have an event or meeting that is not weekly, your convenor should arrive early enough to adjust the heat. Please note that the thermostats revert to their programs after 2 hours. If your event is longer than that you may have to repeat the temporary setting.

Please do not set a thermostat higher than 22 degrees – the room won't warm any faster and energy will be wasted.
