## Financial Update

For the third quarter (July to September), comparisons of actual givings with target givings are shown in the top panel of the table. Actual givings for local purposes were over \$9,000 short of the target for the period.

On a cumulative basis for the nine-month period from January to September, the actual data compared with the target data are shown in the lower panel of the table. There is a significant shortfall in givings for local purposes. This shortfall in givings for local purposes is virtually the same as the deficit for local purposes as of September 30.

The target data are based on historical differences for each quarter. Traditionally, givings are the largest in the final three months of the year. It would be very encouraging if givings for the final three months were even greater than in the past in order to minimize any deficit.
