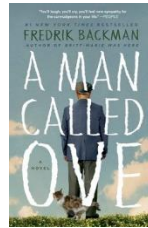

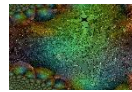

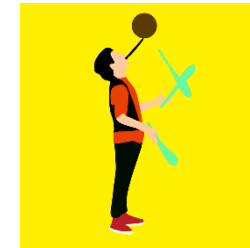

Rick Ojala spent thirty years in the high skilled manufacturing industry, the first ten years helping run a medium sized family business. **Next Sunday, November 19, is the fourth and last special appeal Sunday for the year 2017.** In the past, Parkwood has supported the Inter-Varsity Christian Fellowship, but this time around, we are appealing to our congregation to support the work of **The Navigators, Carleton University chapter.** The Navigators of Canada is part of a global network of Navigator ministries in more than 100 countries globally. The Navigators are a group of people dedicated to following Jesus by living out Jesus' teaching to love God and others. The aim of the movement is to develop apprentices, or what Jesus called disciples, who will in turn mentor others to follow Jesus Christ.
