The Mission Team's Second Special Appeal for 2018 on June 10 is for Emmanuel International Canada (EICanada). If you wish to donate in support of EICanada, you may do so by writing EICanada in the space provided under "Other" on your Offering Envelope.

EICanada is an inter-denominational evangelical Christian organization which partners with local churches in its project countries to address and implement practical physical and spiritual solutions for the specific needs of rural communities in developing countries. EICanada's Christian ministry provides the foundation for the organization's development efforts. The organization is committed to meeting the needs of people regardless of their race, gender, age, colour or religion.

The four main categories in which EICanada concentrates its work are: disaster relief, disaster rehabilitation, sustainable community development and Christian ministries. Through these areas of service and outreach, EICanada works with local churches to meet the specific needs of rural communities, and the needs of the whole person – social, physical, emotional and spiritual.

EICanada's Christian ministry projects include church planting, evangelism, leadership development, discipleship, theological education and Bible school training.
