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EFC Letters Countering MAiD

The Evangelical Fellowship of Canada is encouraging Christians to be aware of the possible extension of MAiD (Medical Assistance in Dying) to those who are only suffering from mental illness and not otherwise nearing death. Efforts to have the government reconsider this matter and ensure protection for people with mental illness from euthanasia are presently underway.
