Financial Update: Budget Deficit

The financial picture changed significantly from the last report as of September 30. Specifically, in October, there was a less-than-average flow of donations and some further major repair and maintenance expenditures. As a result, there was a major increase in the operating deficit during October.

As of October 31, the expenses for repairs and maintenance are \$6,000 above their budget. These expenditures were essential for the operation of our building and could not be delayed.

The Finance Team asks everyone to give special thought to our need for general and repair expenditures when they prepare their financial donations during December.
